

Saturday 7 September DEPART AUSTRALIA

Welcome to Switzerland, a land of snow-capped summits and romantic lakes that has attracted poets, musicians, and travellers for centuries. We will be met at the airport and transferred to our hotel. This evening, we shall enjoy a Welcome Dinner at the hotel in Lucerne.

Monday 9 September LUCERNE SIGHTSEEING

This morning after breakfast, we visit the Swiss Transport Museum. From luxe Monteverdi cars to alpine trains, we discover Switzerland's fascinating transportation and learn about sustainable energy, fossil fuel alternatives and chart the history of alternative transport methods, from horses and steam to electric and solar power.


As evening sets in, we cruise on Lake Lucerne to Stans where a futuristic cable car will carry us up Mount Stanserhorn with the peak at 1,898 metres above sea level. Here we will see amazing Alpine views while enjoying a sumptuous meal at a panoramic restaurant.

Accommodation: Mandarin Oriental Palace in a Lakeview room, or similar.

Tuesday 10 September LUCERNE SIGHTSEEING (B L D)

Say good morning to beautiful Lucerne, with a visit to a Chocolate Factory and discover what makes Swiss chocolate so delicious.

At our lunch at Alpinum Culinarium, we shall see the edible landscape, which is a unique world of experience, created with around 250 different types of fruit and berries as well as an extraordinary herb garden.



This evening, we will enjoy a tasty Swiss meal, including the famous Swiss cheese fondue, in a typical restaurant. While enjoying dinner, you can also join in a lively folklore show which includes yodeling, flagthrowing and Alpine horn-blowing.

Accommodation: Mandarin Oriental Palace in a Lakeview room, or similar.

Wednesday 11 September LUCERNE TO GRINDELWALD

We depart Lucerne after breakfast, and travel south to Grindelwald, embedded in a unique Alpine landscape at the foot of the Eiger north face. On our way we shall stop in at Geissbach for some time to have lunch. Grindelwald is one of Switzerland's most beautiful Alpine towns, so we shall explore this famous glacier village and you will see for yourself why.

Thursday 12 September GRINDELWALD (B L)

This morning, we will enjoy a once in a lifetime chance to travel to the Top of Europe. Our cog railway trip will take us from Grindelwald, through the world famous Eiger Mountain, to Europe's highest railway station at 3,454 m (11,332 ft)! We shall enjoy spectacular views and explore the Ice Palace which is carved inside the biggest glacier in Europe!

We also visit the Grindelwald Museum, which shows the beautifully documented history of this exceptional location. We shall enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before having plenty of time to relax and explore on your own.

Accommodation: Sunstar Hotel Grindelwald, or similar.



Friday 13 September

GRINDELWALD TO ST MORITZ

(B D)

After breakfast we head into the high mountain country of the Grisons Alps and arrive in the sparkling Engadine Valley with an invigorating climate characterised by clear skies and its location high in the Alps. On arrival in the cosmopolitan resort of St. Moritz, we embark on a brief orientation tour including the spa quarter and the brilliantly sparkling glacial lake.

Tonight, we dine at a local restaurant in St Moritz.

Accommodation: **Hotel Reine Victoria**, or similar, for 3 nights.



Saturday 14 September

TIRANO DAY TRIP

(B L)

We travel through the scenic Italian countryside to the fortified town of Tirano and explore the town on a walking tour to view the sights. We shall have a relaxed lunch in town before boarding the UNESCO World Heritage Listed Rhaetian Railway to cross the Bernina Pass and wind our way through scenic landscapes back to the stylish resort town of St. Moritz.

Accommodation: Hotel Reine Victoria, or similar.

Sunday 15 September

ST MORITZ

(B L)

We travel to Pontresina then onto the beautiful Val Roseg to view the mountains and glaciers in a horse drawn carriage. Sit back, relax, and let the horses pull us at a leisurely pace to the Hotel Roseg Gletscher at the far end of the idyllic Val Roseg. At the Hotel Roseg Gletscher, we shall enjoy the gastronomic treats on offer - along with the views of the nearby glaciers and the impressive Bernina massif. We return to the hotel by coach.

Accommodation: Hotel Reine Victoria, or similar.



Monday 16 September

ST MORTIZ TO ZERMATT

(B L)

Today, we board one of the world's most iconic trains, the Glacier Express and spend the day taking in vistas of ice capped mountains, stone-built villages, and lush meadows. Our glass-roofed carriage offers panoramic views as we cross the iconic Land Wasser viaduct. We travel along the Rhine through deep valleys and snowcapped mountains, before ascending over 6,600 feet to the top of the Oberalp Pass. Picturesque gorges and waterfalls of the Matter valley then guide us into tonight's destination, Zermatt.

Accommodation: **Hotel Zermama** in a Matterhorn view room, or similar, for 2 nights.



Tuesday 17 September

ZERMATT

(B L)

This morning, we embark on an orientation drive to feast our eyes on the distinctive triangular silhouette of the Matterhorn. Later, a unique electric taxi service will drive to the foot of Zermatt's highest and most spectacular mountain ride. We will enjoy stunning views as we ascend to Furi and Trockener Steg, before boarding Europe's highest cable car to 3883m (12,740 ft) to view the magnificent snow-capped top of the world.

Accommodation: Hotel Zermama in a Matterhorn view room, or similar.

Wednesday 18 September

ZERMATT TO MONTREUX

(BD)

We depart Zermatt and journey to the resort town of Montreux, set against the pristine backdrop of snow-covered peaks and vineyards. At the foot of the Alps this town boasts one of the most beautiful walks along Lake Geneva, we take a town walk before we travel along the shores of Lake Geneva to visit a winery. We admire the stunning panorama overlooking the lake and savour a tasting of tantalising, local wine and delight in a delicious dinner this evening.

Accommodation: **Eden Palace Au Lac**, or similar, for 3 nights.

Thursday 19 September

MONTREUX

(B)

On the western bay of Lake Geneva, we visit Chillon Castle for a special tour of the former home to the Dukes of Savoy, immortalised by Lord Byron's 'Prisoner of Chillon.' Keep a look out for where the writer is rumoured to have left his mark. After our morning of sightseeing journey to Gruyeres, where we will visit a cheese factory, you will have the opportunity to indulge in a cheese tasting. Next, we visit the Chaplin's World, a large-scale museum dedicated to Charlie Chaplin and his life's work. Immerse yourself through the sets of his greatest films at this Hollywood-style Studio and take a peaceful walk in the gardens.

Accommodation: Eden Palace Au Lac, or similar.



Friday 20 September

MONTREUX - BERN DAY TRIP

(B)

Today we have a full day sightseeing as we travel to Bern, first making a stop in Lausanne. During our time in Lausanne, we will visit the Olympic Museum dedicated to the spirit of the olympics and take a stroll through the old town to admire the majestic 12th-century Gothic cathedral.

We continue onto Bern where our exploration with a local guide through Switzerland's capital includes seeing the floral displays, Cathedral of St. Vincent, Federal Palace, clock tower, Ogre Fountain, and Parliament House., We also visit The Einsteinhaus, a museum and a former residence of Albert Einstein. We return to Montreux in the afternoon.

Accommodation: Eden Palace Au Lac, or similar.

Saturday 21 September

MONTREUX – GENEVA

(BD)

Today we follow the shores of the lake to the international city of Geneva where we enjoy an orientation tour before we relax in comfort on the waters of Lake Geneva during a highlight cruise.

Tonight, we dine in a local restaurant for a celebration dinner and toast a successful trip!

Accommodation: InterContinental Geneva, or similar, for one night.

Sunday 22 September Paris Embark Cruise (B D)

This morning, you depart Geneva and travel to Paris where you will board the Uniworld Paris to Normandy Cruise. S.S. Joie de Vivre brings the "joy of living" to the rivers of France. Monday 23 September La Roche-Guyon, Vernon, Giverny (B L D)

Today is a celebration of northern France's natural beauty, with an excursion to a splendid château and gardens situated in an equally grand setting, plus a chance to immerse yourself in the very landscapes that inspired Impressionist master Claude Monet.

In the morning, choose between a scenic hike or a visit to the hilltop Château de La Roche-Guyon, which is surrounded by beautiful gardens and offers sweeping views over the Seine.

Later, explore the beautiful gardens of Monet. You'll have the opportunity to take in the French countryside on your way there with an invigorating bike ride, or opt to arrive by coach instead. This evening, a special Captain's Welcome Reception and Dinner will be prepared for you.

Tuesday 24 September Rouen (B L D)

Walk in the footsteps of greatness in Normandy's medieval capital, a city with a historic quarter that remains amazingly intact. From the cathedral Monet painted dozens of times to the cross marking the spot where Joan of Arc was martyred, Rouen is a treasure trove for the culturally curious.

The roll call of famous people who lived or died in Rouen is long and varied—Richard the Lionheart, Joan of Arc, Gustave Flaubert and Claude Monet are among them.

Wednesday 25 September Caudebec-En-Caux (Honfleur Or Étretat) (B L D)

Caudebec-en-Caux, a lovely little town on the right bank of the Seine Estuary, is your base for one of two very different excursions. You could drive through the beautiful Calvados countryside to Honfleur, a delightful seaside harbor and city of painters, or head to the windy cliffs of Étretat for a game of golf.

Thursday 26 September Rouen (Normandy Beaches) (B L D)

There are moments when we travel that move us on an otherworldly level—experiences that stir a profound emotional connection. The Normandy beaches certainly have that effect. On your full-day outing, you'll visit Normandy's beaches, including Utah Beach and Ste-Mère-Église, with a choice to venture to either the American, British and Commonwealth, or Canadian beaches. After, you'll partake in a private ceremony at the Omaha Beach Memorial—a sentimental remembrance of Operation Overlord.









Friday 27 September

Mantes-La-Jolie (Versailles)

(B L D)

How did France's rulers live over the centuries? Step into the private rooms of the Palace of Versailles, the lavish palace built by the Sun King. It was the official residence of the country's kings and queens from 1682 until the revolution, and though the monarchy possessed other palaces, Versailles stood alone in magnificence. Tour the royal apartments, which still look much as they did when Louis XVI and Marie Antoinette fled in...

A special Captain's Farewell Reception and Dinner will be prepared for you this evening.

Saturday 28 September Paris

Whether you are a first-time visitor to the "City of Light" or you have been here many times before, there is something for everyone today in Paris. Enjoy a panoramic overview of the city, join a local expert for a walk through two much-loved neighborhoods, or pedal your way along the Left Bank, a fresh and fun way to take in the sights.



INTRODUCTION:

This contract is governed by Gippsland Travel Centre Pty Ltd and all members of the travelling parties as listed on your itinerary. Gippsland Travel Centre acts as the agent selling and coordinating products on behalf of a third-party travel supplier/s. A separate contract with the supplier/s will apply and will be governed by the supplier's Terms and Conditions. Gippsland Travel cannot guarantee the performance of any third-party supplier/s. Gippsland Travel may receive fees, commissions, gifts or financial incentives from third party supplier/s under this contract.

COVID POLICY

If the tour cannot operate due to COVID-19 state border closures and restrictions, the tour will be rescheduled and any funds paid will be transferred to the new tour date.

Due to the ongoing and evolving Covid-19 situation in Australia we have been advised by our suppliers that all guests must be fully vaccinated against Covid-19. Fully vaccinated means that there has been at least 14 clear days from the second dose and the date of our departure. Those who have a medical exemption from receiving the Covid-19 vaccine can still travel. Guests will be required to show a Covid-19 vaccine medical contraindication prior to our departure.

LATE BOOKINGS

PASSPORT and VISA

HEALTH & FITNESS

FORCE MAJEURE:

Force Majeure means the occurrence of an event that is beyond Gippsland Travel's reasonable control and which could not have been reasonably prevented by Gippsland Travel. Force majeure includes, but is not limited to: acts of God, accident, riots, war, terrorist act, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, outbreaks of infectious disease or any other public health crisis, civil commotion, breakdown of communication facilities, natural catastrophes and natural disasters (including but not limited to flooding, fire, earthquake, landslide), adverse weather conditions, high or low water levels; government directed travel restrictions or omissions, changes in laws or regulations, national strikes, explosion, generalised lack of availability of raw materials or energy, nuclear or other industrial accident causing environmental pollution or contamination; change in law, meaning, enactment, amendment (including repeal) in the law or administration of any law in Australia or any jurisdiction or territory relevant to the booking contract, which includes changes in statute, regulation, determination, by-law, declaration, licence and the common law as applicable from time to time.

For the avoidance of doubt, Force Majeure shall not include (a) financial distress nor inability of either party to make a profit or avoid a financial loss, (b) changes in market prices or conditions, or (c) a party's financial inability to perform its obligations hereunder.

In the event that a Force Majeure is declared, the customer will be bound by the third-party supplier/s Terms and Conditions, if applicable.

TERMINATION OF BOOKING CONTRACT OR CHANGE OF TRAVEL ARRANGEMENTS DUE TO FORCE MAJEURE

If Gippsland Travel, in its reasonable opinion, considers that any Force Majeure event prevents Gippsland Travel (whether directly or through its employees, contractors, subcontractors and agents) from lawfully or safely providing any products or services subject of the booking contract with you, Gippsland Travel may immediately by written notice; (a) terminate the booking contract (in whole or part of); or (b) change your travel arrangements as reasonably practicable to ensure your safety and invoice for any additional costs. If you are eligible for a refund once a booking has been cancelled, the balance less any non-refundable amounts will be forwarded to you once received by Gippsland Travel from the third-party supplier/s. Gippsland Travel is not responsible for any delays of refunds from the third-party supplier/s. Refunds from third party supplier/s can take in excess of 6 weeks. Refunds will be processed as per original form of payment.

Travel insurance policies may provide cover for cancellation fees subject to their terms and conditions.

LIMITATION OF LIABILITY:

Subject to Australian Consumer Law, Gippsland Travel does not accept any liability in contract, tort or otherwise for any injury, damage, loss, delay, additional expense or inconvenience caused by a third-party supplier/s over who we have no direct control. Gippsland Travel is not liable for Force Majeure or any other event which is beyond our control or which is not preventable by us.
